# Bingo Game

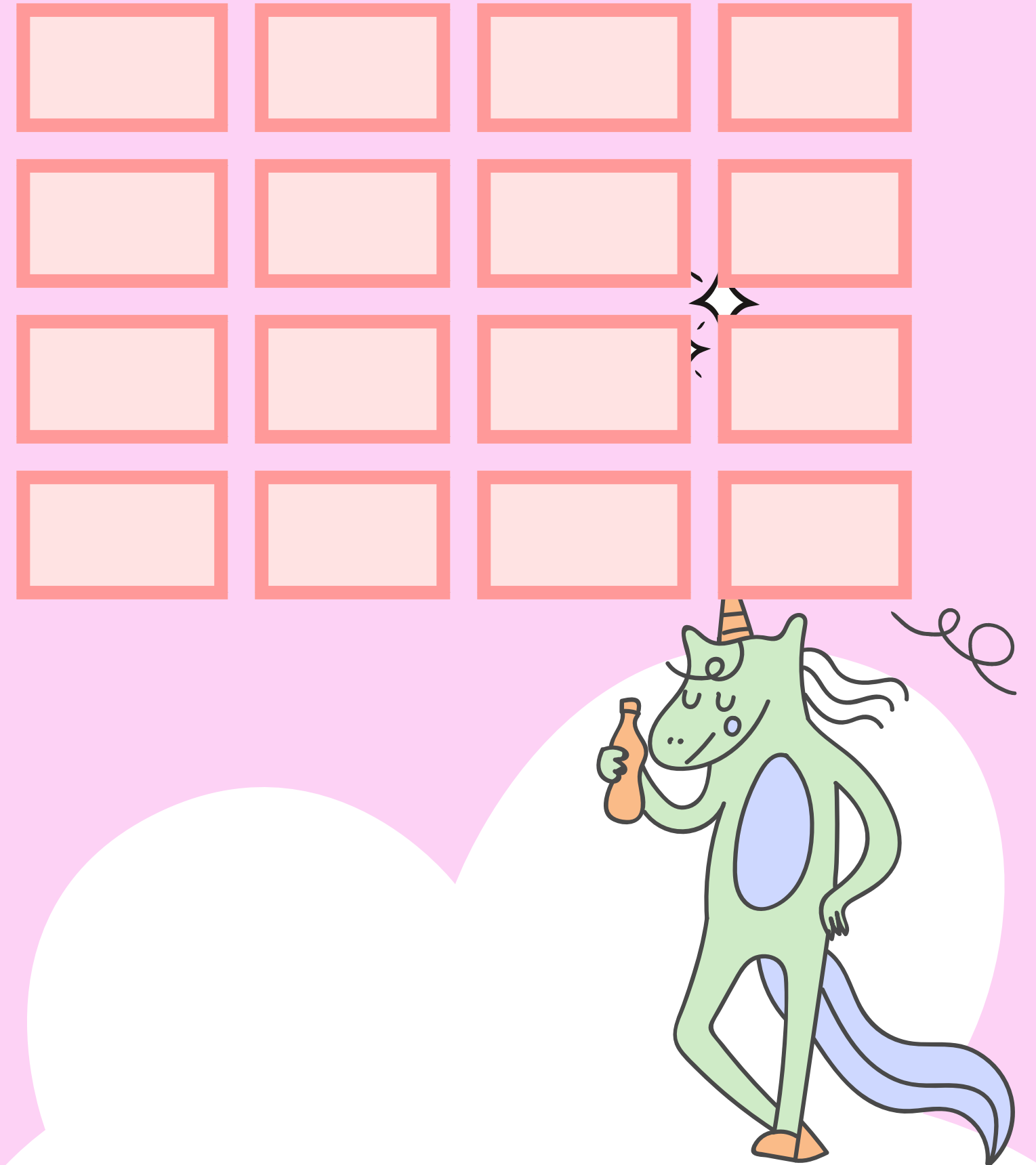
Preparation:

Create Friendship Bingo Cards:

Prepare a Bingo card for each student with a 4x4 grid (16 squares). Each square should contain a word or phrase related to friendship characteristics (e.g., "loyal," "kind," "helpful," "sharing," "honest," "listens well," etc.).

How to Play:

- 1. Start the Game:** Once everyone has their Bingo card ready, explain that they are going to listen for different friendship characteristics as you call them out. Each student will mark the corresponding word on their card.
- 2. Call Out the Words:** As the teacher, you will call out the friendship characteristics one at a time. For example: "Kind" "Honest" "Helpful" "Listens well"
- 3. Mark the Cards:** Students will listen carefully and mark the word if they have it on their Bingo card. They can use a pen, pencil, or any tool available in your online platform (e.g., Zoom's "annotate" tool, or simply crossing off the word on a printed version)
- 4. Winning the Game:** The first student to get 5 marks in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) should say "Bingo!" in the chat or unmute their microphone to announce it.
- 5. Verify the Bingo:** Ask the winning student to read out the words in their Bingo row to ensure they've marked them correctly. If everything checks out, congratulate them as the winner!
