Choose the option that best matches your opinion and consider your reasons for this belief. Try to think of some evidence for your opinion.




Be ready to share your opinion and reasoning and be open to hearing different perspectives from your classmates.







Cinderella would've been happier if she hadn't gone to the ball.



The witch in "Hansel and Gretel" was just misunderstood and lonely.




The Little Mermaid gave up too much for love.




Goldilocks was wrong to enter the bears' house without permission.




Rapunzel was right to trust the prince rather than staying isolated in the tower.




Jack was wrong to steal from the giant in "Jack and the Beanstalk."




The witch in "Rapunzel" had good intentions in keeping Rapunzel in the tower.
