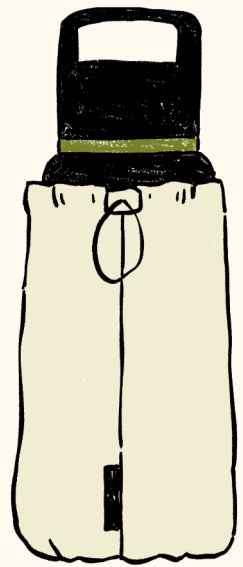

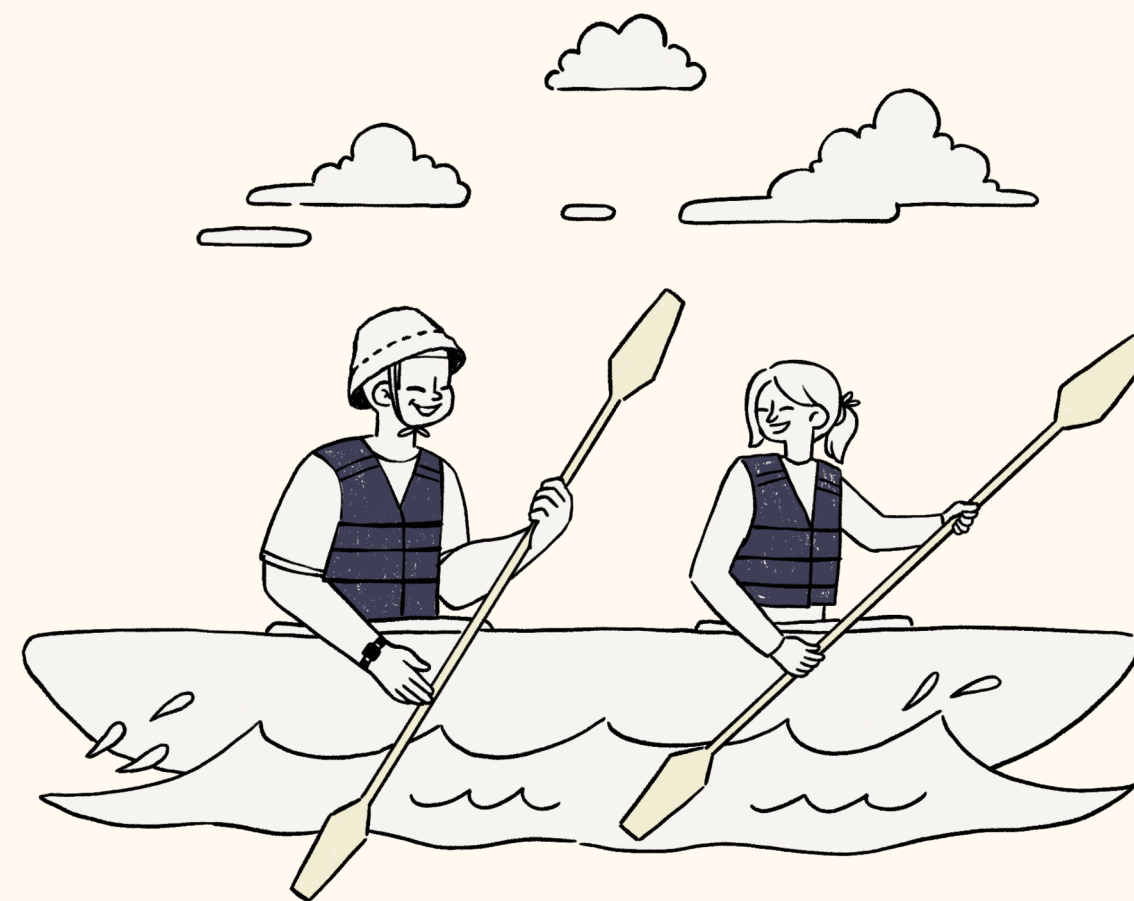

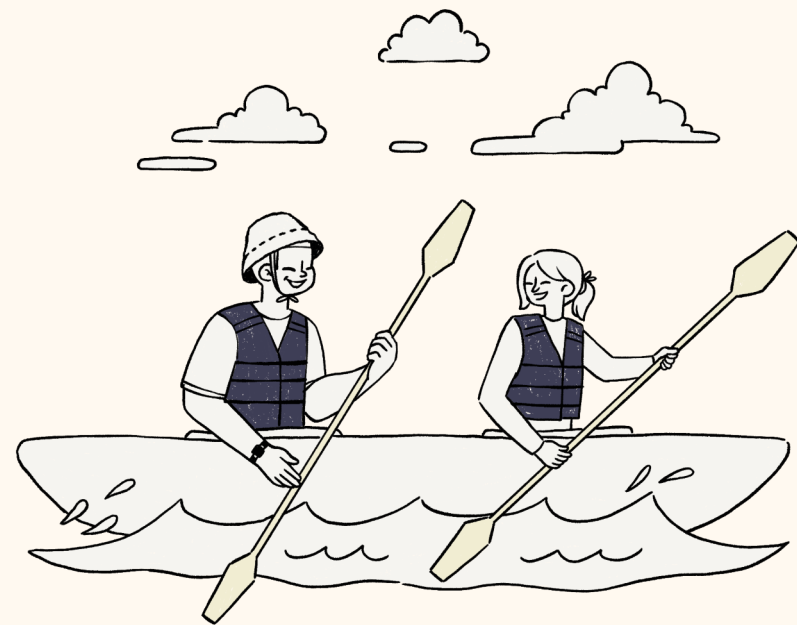
Word	Part of Speech	Definition	Example Sentence
Journey	Noun	An act of traveling from one place to another, especially when they are far apart.	The journey from London to Paris took about two hours by train.
Luggage	Noun	Bags, cases, and belongings of a traveler.	I packed my luggage the night before the flight.
Tourist	Noun	A person who is traveling or visiting a place for pleasure.	The city is always crowded with tourists in the summer.
Itinerary	Noun	A detailed plan or route of a journey.	The tour company sent us a detailed itinerary of our trip.
Destination	Noun	The place to which someone is going or being sent.	Paris is a popular destination for romantic getaways.
Explore	Verb	To travel to or around an area or a country to learn about it.	We decided to explore the nearby mountains during our stay.
Depart	Verb	To leave, especially to start a journey.	The train departs from platform five at 10 a.m.
Book	Verb	To arrange for someone to have a seat, room, or ticket in advance.	We need to book a hotel for our trip to Rome.
Pack	Verb	To put clothes and other belongings into a suitcase or bag.	Don't forget to pack your passport and travel documents.
Navigate	Verb	To find the way to get to a place, especially by using a map.	We used GPS to navigate through the unfamiliar city.

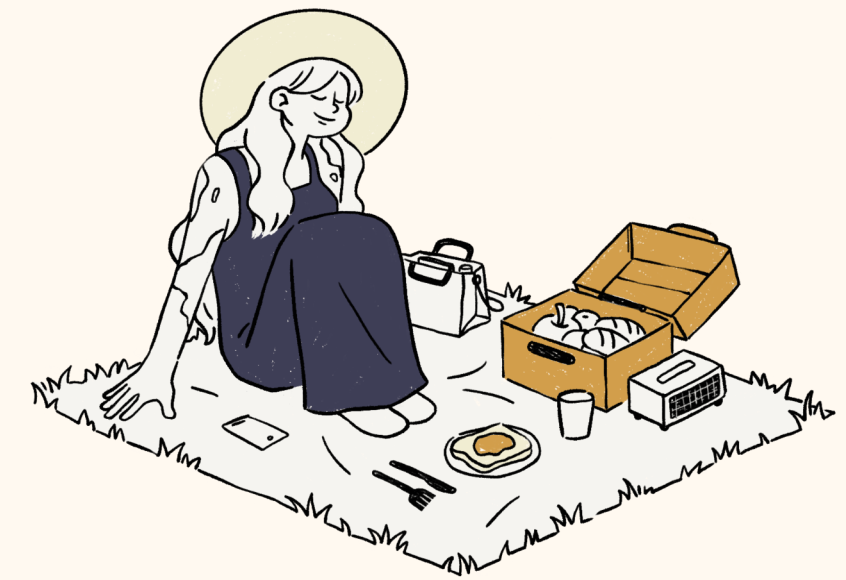

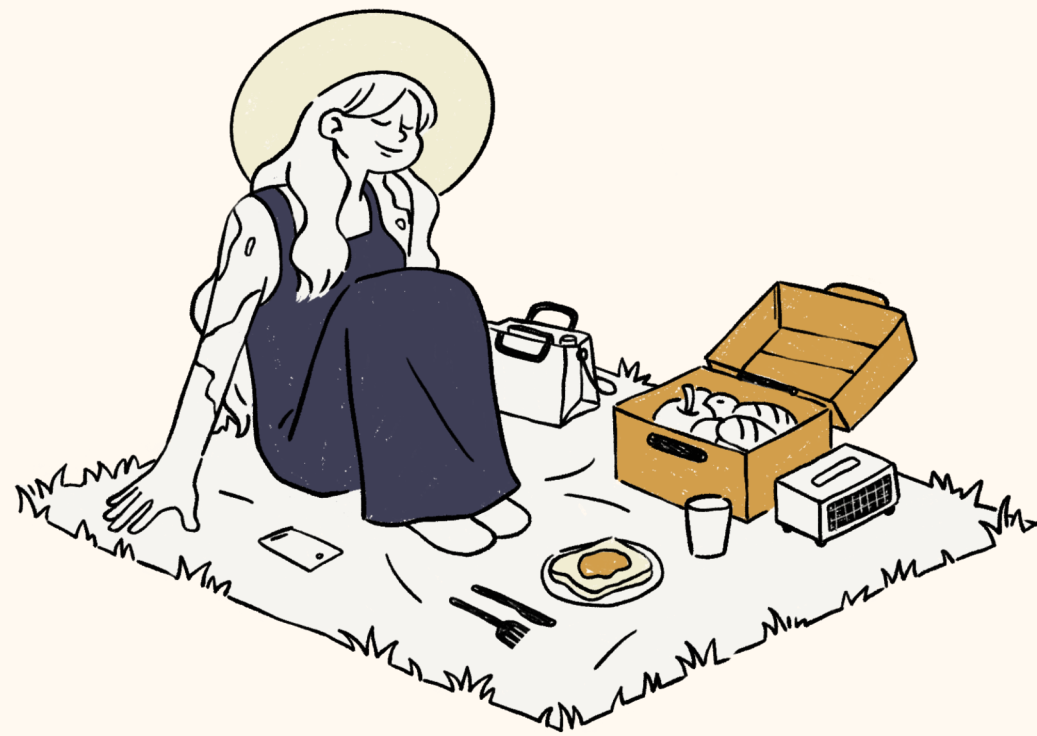
Word	Part of Speech	Definition	Example Sentence
Breathtaking	Adjective	Extremely beautiful or amazing.	The view from the mountain was breathtaking.
Exotic	Adjective	Unusual and exciting because it is connected to a foreign country.	They visited an exotic island in the Pacific.
Relaxing	Adjective	Making you feel relaxed and free from stress.	The beach vacation was so relaxing.
Adventurous	Adjective	Willing to take risks or try out new ideas or experiences.	He has an adventurous spirit and loves trying new things while traveling.
Passport	Noun	An official document issued by a government that allows someone to travel abroad.	Don't forget to bring your passport to the airport.
Sightseeing	Noun	The activity of visiting interesting places, especially by tourists.	We spent the afternoon sightseeing around the city.
Customs	Noun	The place at a port, airport, or border where officials check goods and people.	We had to go through customs when entering the country.
Souvenir	Noun	Something kept as a reminder of a place, event, or experience.	I bought a small statue as a souvenir from my trip to Thailand.
Accommodation	Noun	A place to stay, such as a hotel, during a trip.	We found comfortable accommodation near the beach.
Visa	Noun	An official mark or stamp in a passport that allows you to enter or leave a country.	You'll need a visa to travel to some countries.

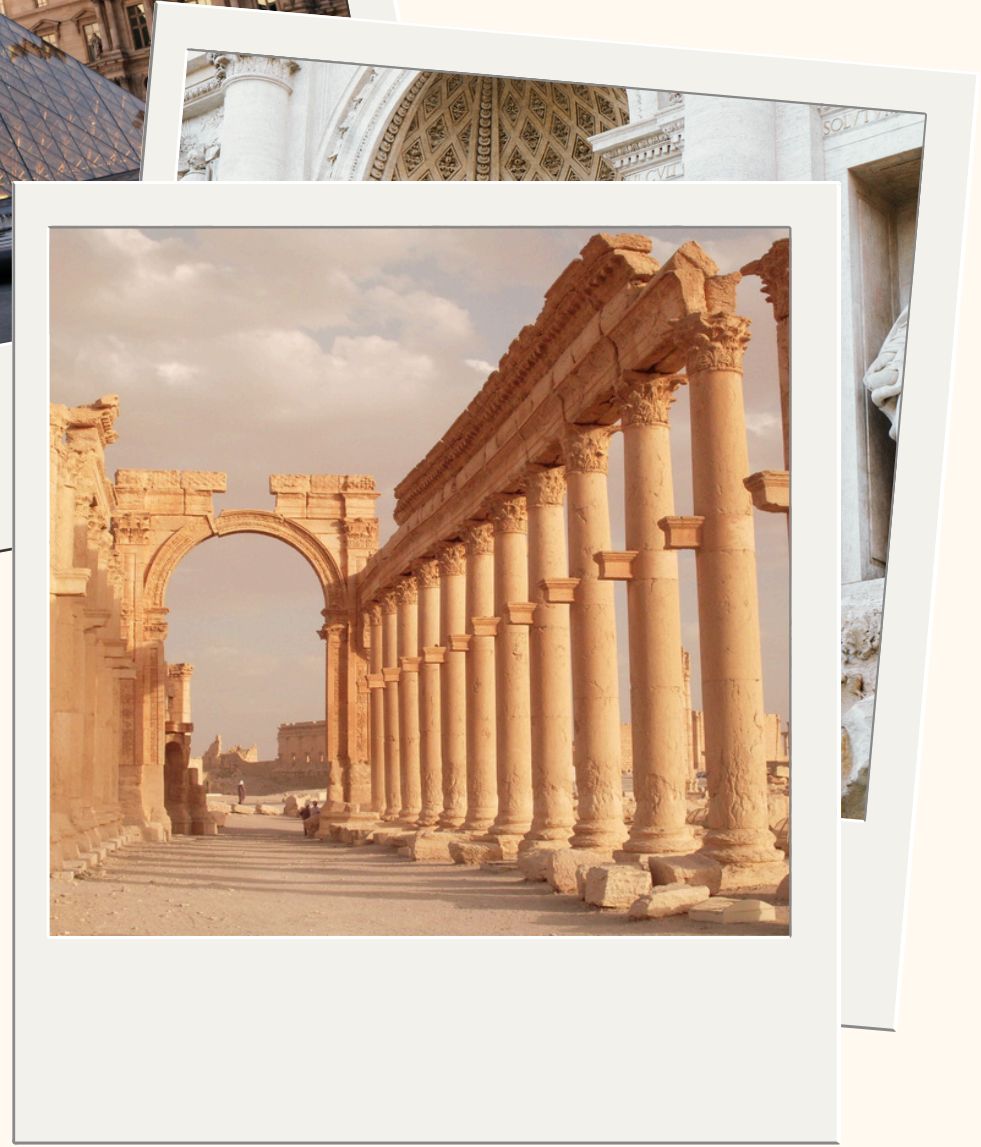
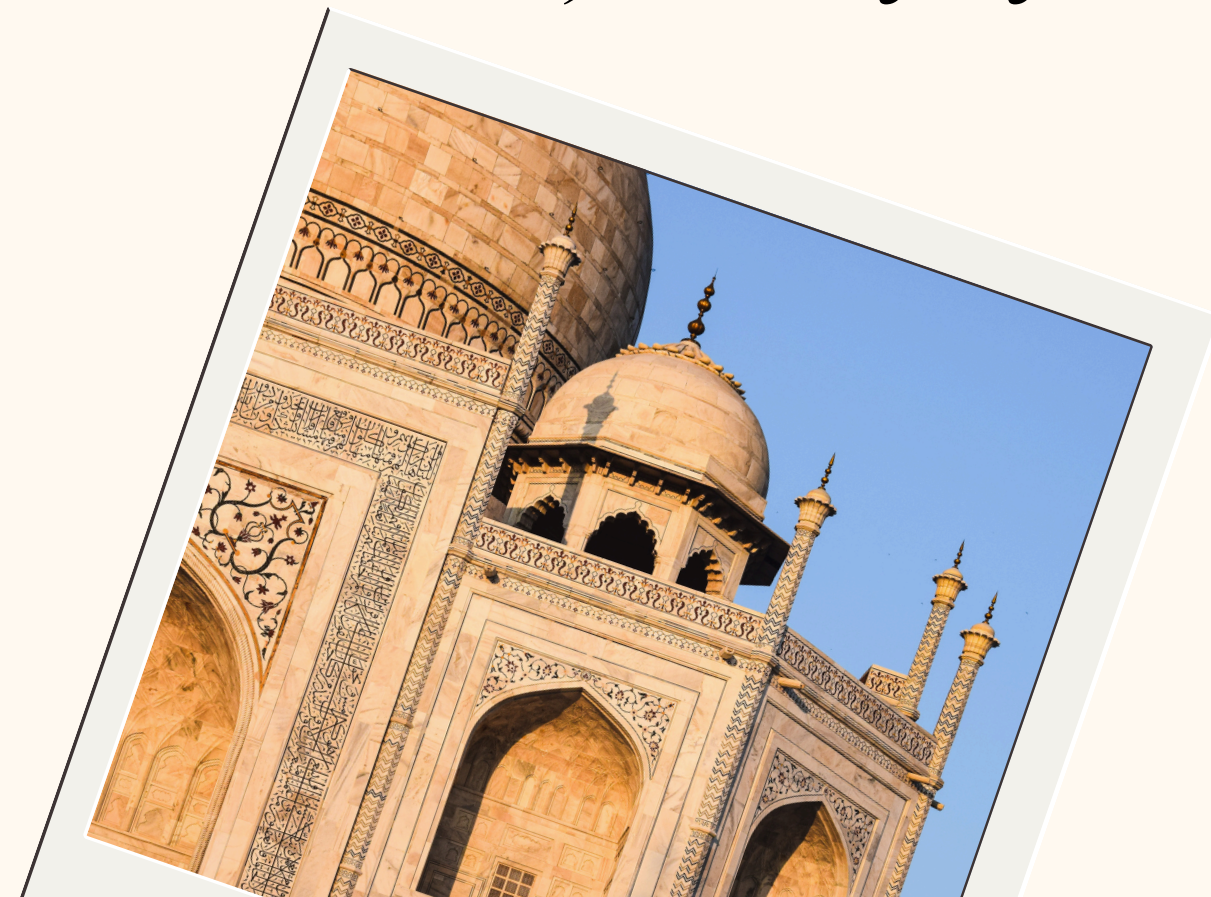

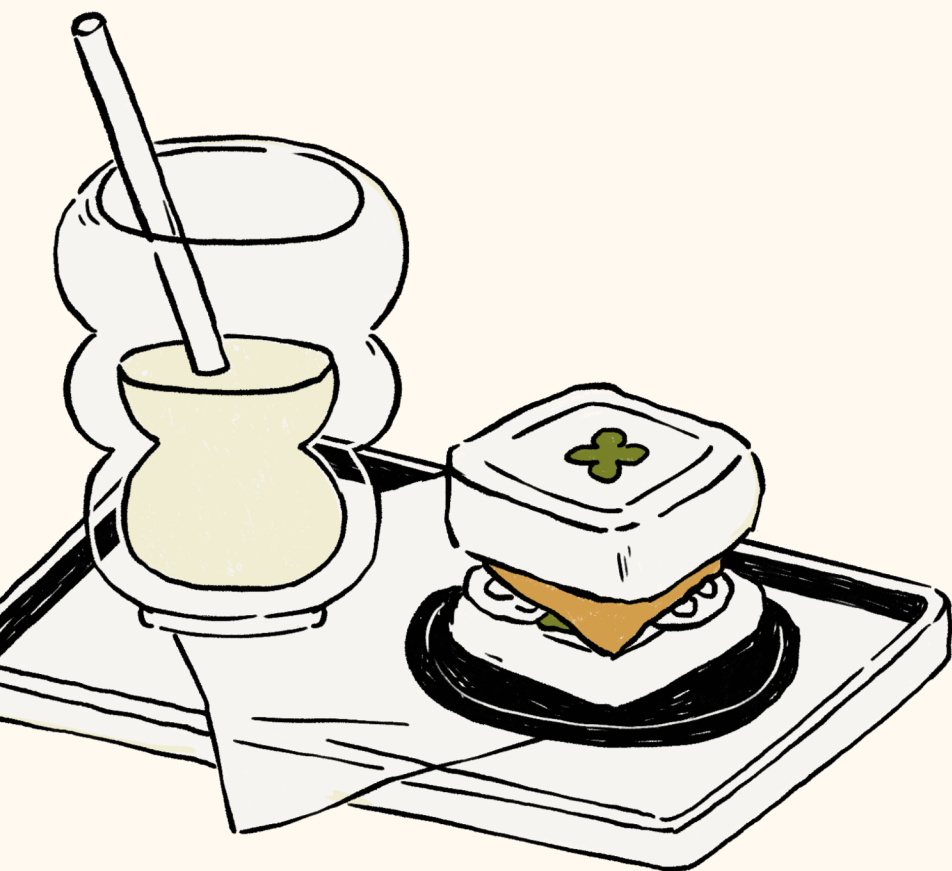
